About the Organisation and Programme:

Bodh Shiksha Samiti is a not for profit organisation (based out of Jaipur) working in the field of quality education for the last 30 years. The organization strives to contribute towards ensuring equitable quality education for all the children irrespective of their socio, economic backgrounds. Bodh also works closely with the state governments to strengthen the public education system so that the quality of education provided to the masses improves and becomes what the national curriculum aims to be ensuring.

The positions are for Centre for Education and Learning, a research and development centre established in Bodh's Jaipur campus for finding material, strategic and capacity building solutions to the problems faced in school education. The centre is established recently and is in the initial phase of evolution. The centre is presently supported financially by *The Michael and Susan Dell Foundation* and *The Avanti Learning Centre*.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- The Sr. Fellows would lead the academic activities like creation of content (teaching learning materials, videos/workbooks/teacher's guidebooks) for secondary grades (classes 9th and 10th) for their subject for Hindi based NCERT curriculum.
- Along with intense involvement in the curriculum and content development work, the Sr. Fellows would also engage in capacity building (subject based) of the Government (selected schools of the programme) and Bodhshalas.
- They would also be required to field test the materials in the research school of the centre named Manas Ganga situated on campus. Mentoring the fellows and teachers of the centres and Manas Ganga school would be one of the core responsibilities of the Sr. Fellows.
- **Any other task pertaining to the organisation and the programme.**

Qualification and Experience:

- Masters (In the subject for which they are applying). Candidates applying for social science should be comfortable with at least 2 of the 4 subjects taught in the secondary grades – political science, history, geography and economics.
- A minimum of 5 years' experience of working on content development, trainings, teaching would be preferred.

Note: Only a person who is willing to work for at least one year in the institution should apply.
